The competition, "SAVE AS YOU BUILD" is an attempt to bring the ingenuity of creative minds into the limelight through our platform and to showcase their innovations in the field of Architecture, Building and Construction, Interiors, Carpeting, Flooring technology and the like.

What can one save? We welcome your ideas to save anything that is of value - building cost, environment, water, power, lives, communities etc. It could even be an idea that will help mitigate the after-effects of a disaster or lower travelling distances through intelligent transportation planning. A social worker may come with a socially-relevant idea which may save space when planning settlements. So the possibilities are endless.

Over the years one has seen simple innovations in construction that have resulted in enormous savings – rat-trap masonry, soil-cement blocks, filler-slab roofing, ferro-cement, frameless doors and windows, ecosan are some such ideas. The water being used today in flush cisterns is much lower than that was the case a few years ago. Air conditioning systems today are much more effective due to design changes. Simple ideas – contraptions that have been added or small changes in the existing system have resulted in ingenious solutions that save.

Who can participate?

Since the scope is really vast the gamut of possibilities are limitless, the eligibility criteria are also without bounds students, architects, engineers, social workers, artists - in short anyone who has an brainwave that they believe can make a difference is welcome to send in their thought. Team compositions may be as low as one member or a maximum of three members.

What are you expected to submit?

You could choose to express your idea through a medium that you are comfortable with. Written matter should be between 700-1000 words. It would be advisable to include sketches, flowcharts and drawings that may be required to explain your idea. The number of A3 size sheets should not exceed 4.

What do you stand to gain?

This would be an opportunity for you to let your imagination loose and present ideas that could be seen as the real light of day. The best three entries will be awarded cash prizes of Rs.30000, Rs.20000 and Rs.15000 along with certificates and trophies. The teams presenting the top ten unique ideas will be invited to the exhibition to exhibit their entries. The top ten teams will also be given an opportunity and all the support to erect or construct a scaled model / prototype of the suggested idea at the exhibition. The presence of the leading manufacturers - Indian and International could open up a host of possibilities for your unique idea.
